

VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

INPATIENTS ALLOWED ONE (1) DESIGNATED VISITOR

- NO VISITORS are permitted for patients in isolation or those who have a COVID-19 diagnosis.
- Visitors will be given an ID bracelet, replaced daily.
- Visitors may only enter once each day through the Main Entrance between the hours of 5 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on weekdays and from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. on weekends.
- Visitors are welcome to stay as long as they like within routine hospital visiting hours.
- Visitors must be 18 years of age or older.

EVERYONE WILL BE SCREENED UPON ENTRY

ALL VISITORS MUST WEAR A MASK

Including in hallways, public areas and in patients rooms.

WASH YOUR HANDS before entering a patient room and prior to leaving the facility

Sinks and hand sanitizers are available throughout the building.

DO NOT VISIT IF YOU ARE ILL

EMERGENCY ROOM: Only one (1) visitor per patient is allowed in the Emergency Department

COMPASSIONATE EXCEPTIONS
